**Question 1 (received Jan 22, 2021, 3:42 PM)**

**For "Segment 2 RCSD to Member Districts - Optional Additional Termination Connections" as described on pg 4 of the RFP."**

**a. Will you select only one of the three site options for the Z or termination address? Either 224 Lincoln, 2 Tiger Way or 8809 Cook Riolo?**

The information provided in the RFP is to make it clear that a fully connected pathway between the consortium members (RCSD, DCJESD, RJUHSD) and Placer County Office of Education needs to be handed off to a successful bidder.

Currently, it is the members responsibility to connect to the current provider, Consolidated Communications Inc, who will feed the RCSD District office via a VLAN sharing arrangement over a 1GB link (#2 in Appendix B).

Any provider who proposes an alternative method, would need to replicate the connections between the consortium members and Placer County Office of Education.

Unless proposed differently, the expectation is that existing network would stand and the circuit from #2 in Appendix B would be renewed.

**b. If 1a is "No" will all 3 locations need to have separate ELINE point to point circuits back to 1050 Main St?**

For item #1 to be a 'No', a winning bid would need to provide an alternative solution that would meet the goal of providing consortium members a full connection to each other and Placer County Office of Education.

**Question 2 (received Jan 22, 2021, 3:42 PM)**

**Since 224 Lincoln is not a RCSD owned facility what is the current location of the ECSD owned switch that is currently serving the consortium members today who are accessing the 1G Internet circuit?**

The consortium currently has a inter-vlan agreement with the existing carrier, Consolidated Communications Inc (CCI), and it's members to feed 1Gb (#2 in Appendix B) link to route and connect to the circuit going to Placer County Office of Education (#1 in Appendix B).

The consortium is always open to alternative ideas and ways to reduce network complexity, costs and we would suggest bidders to include them as optional proposals.
