Question 1:

What is the Class of Service (Basic, Priority, or Premium) required for each bandwidth?

Without more details on what these different services provide, we are not able to answer this question.

The expectation is that this network is to have minimal latency and jitter as they carry both voice and video throughout the network, along with general daily network and internet traffic. Most all traffic within the District goes through the District Office, including any voice service that originates or is destined outside of the district, along with all internet traffic. I hope this provides an answer to your question.

Question 2:

Is voice traffic being deliver across the WAN?

Yes, voice traffic is carried across these circuits.

Question 3:

What is the type of interface handoff requirement - RJ-45 copper or SMF/MMF fiber?

All 1Gbps handoffs should be RJ-45 copper. All handoffs above 1Gbps will be via MMF.
