enchmark Curriculum	Discussion	<p>Aaron Barfield Jessica Marquez</p>	<p>Jessica shared what a day looks like in Kindergarten in the Benchmark curriculum. She showed different read alouds the students have completed, the daily activities, anchor charts. Kindergarten is finishing up the last five days of the first 20 days of curriculum which is setting up procedures and routines.</p> <p>3rd Grade (Aaron) - Curriculum focuses on similar topics, but progresses up through the grade levels. Timing has been challenging right now as students do not have the background knowledge of the curriculum yet. Aaron presented the shared reading book that students can annotate in on their own which teaches them how to annotate. He shared the different units and how they link with other units in Science and other subjects. Aaron brought in a student example to show student annotations, he explained how they are previewing the text before even reading and writing component that is involved. Students are encouraged to work in small groups, pairs, and learn how to communicate with each other. Routines will continue to get easier as students have the curriculum from Kindergarten all the way through 5th grade. Timing of all of the lessons is continuing to be a concern but teachers are working through this.</p> <p>The integration of cross-curricular content has been great.</p>
